

## Coal Slurry Injection and Well Water in Rawl, Mingo County, W.Va.



Kenny Stroud and his neighbors in Rawl, Lick Creek, Merrimac and Sprigg have contaminated wells. They believe the billions of gallons of coal waste slurry the Rawl Sales and Processing plant injected underground polluted their once-clean water. Rawl Sales is a Massey Energy subsidiary.



For 13 years, area people have been pleading for city water—pleading while watching many family members and neighbors become ill. The water lines are *finally* going in. Until such time as the city water is running from people's faucets, Massey Energy has been ordered to provide bottled water to some area families. The people still have to use the contaminated water for bathing and washing.



Mingo County residents who live with this water demand to know what is in the slurry Rawl Sales pumped underground. They don't want any other communities to go through what they have.
